♠ 3 to 12 January – Best of Tasmania Bridge Tour

This holiday features a wonderful combination of bridge, scenery, nature, history and art. Tour highlights include a Tamar River cruise, a tour to see the spectacular beauty of Dove Lake and Cradle Mountain, a Gordon River and Macquarie Harbour cruise, a train journey on the historic West Coast Wilderness Railway, a scenic flight from Strahan to Hobart and a visit to the exciting MONA.



♥ 2 to 5 April – Port Stephens Bridge Holiday

Just a few hours drive north of Sydney, beautiful Port Stephens has sparkling waterways and glorious beaches set around national parks. We stay at the Anchorage, wonderfully positioned right on the waterfront at Corlette, and looking terrific with newly decorated rooms in coastal Hamptons style. 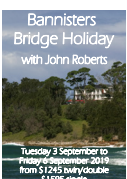
♥ 23 to 30 July – Broome Bridge Holiday

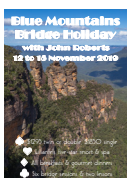
♦ 3 to 10 August – Port Douglas Bridge Holiday
